

# NAVIGATING MANDURAH ESTUARY



Safest entry angle – generally 12 to 15 feet deep.  
Enter from W to NW then aim for central estuary.

Deepest line in estuary is centre to western side  
and the yellow dot is reported “knob” so west is  
best.

The red dot is the inner channel port marker.

The sand shifts constantly and quickly so at times  
there may be a build up of sand in the black ring  
area. At present it is quite deep at 12-13 feet.

The dark line is mainly seaweed but do not exit the  
estuary and turn right as there are two large sand  
bars out to the E – NE.

The blue dot is actually the “yellow middle mark”  
the deeper side is the entry. The exit side has a  
sand build up north where the weed shadow and  
purple star are.

The track as laid out is on average a minimum of 12  
to a max of 16 feet deep and deeper out in the bay.
