## SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSIs)

The Organising Authority (OA) is Fremantle Sailing Club (FSC).

**AMENDED 28/02/2025**

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1.

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. The ORWA SIs 2024-2025 and as modified by these SSIs.
- 1.3. The navigation rules of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (IRPCAS) replace RRS Part 2 between the time of sunset and sunrise.
- 1.4. Appendix T Arbitration shall apply.
- 1.5. **FSC Success Cup Series Only**
- 1.5.1. IRC Rule 21.4 Endorsed Sail Measurement Stamp does not apply.
- 1.5.2. IRC Standard or Endorsed certificates are acceptable.

### 2. COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- 2.1. Notices to Competitors (NTCs) will be posted on the ONB at:

- 2.2. The primary race channel is VHF 72. On the water, the Race Committee intends to monitor and communicate with competitors on VHF channel 72, 82 and 16.

### 3. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 3.1. Signals made ashore will be displayed from the main flag mast located on the VIP lawn at FSC.
- 3.2. When flag 'AP' is displayed ashore. '1 minute is replaced with 'not less than 45 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

### 4. SCHEDULE OF RACE

- 4.1. The schedule of race is as follows:

- 4.2. To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.

### 5. COURSES & RACING AREA

- 5.1. Refer SSI Attachment A Courses.
- 5.2. Refer SSI Attachment B Racing Area.
- 5.3. No course flag will be displayed.

## 6. MARKS

In addition to marks listed in SI Appendix A.

## 7. SHORTENING COURSE

RRS 32.2(a) applies. The Race Committee may advise shortening of course via VHF 72 & 82.

## 8. THE FINISH

- 8.1. The finishing line is between a staff displaying a blue flag on the Race Committee vessel and the course side of the finishing mark.
- 8.2. The finishing line will be located in the vicinity of 32° 30.60'S & 115° 42.60'E.

## 9. PENALTY SYSTEM

Scoring Penalty – for some specific breaches of the rules, the Race Committee may apply a scoring penalty [SP] without a hearing. The Race Committee may still protest a boat when they consider the SP inappropriate. The scoring penalty is 2 points. This changes Appendix A5.

## 10. TIME LIMITS

There is no race time limit.

## 11. HEARING REQUESTS

- 11.1. Hearing request forms are available from the Official Sailing Notice Board located near the southwest entrance of MOFSC Clubhouse.
- 11.2. Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held in the FSC Activities Room unless advised otherwise.
- 11.3. A boat intending to protest any other boat for any incident occurring in the racing area shall in addition to the existing requirements of RRS 60.2 make a VHF call to inform the other boat of her intention to "Protest" at the first reasonable opportunity for each incident. This changes RRS rules 60.2 (a)(1) and 60.2 (b)(1).

## 12. POSITION REPORTS [SP][NP]

- 12.1. Boats shall report to Race Control by VHF at the first reasonable opportunity after rounding or passing the mark designated in the courses.
- 12.2. If unable to contact Race Control by VHF, contact by phone: 0478 637 135.

## 13. PRIZES

The prize presentation will be held in the Marina Bar at MOFSC on Saturday 08 March 2025 approximately 1 hour after the last boat finishes.
