SAIL PAST

At the commencement of the Sail Past, Success will lead the procession past the official boats. Participating boats shall form a single line behind their respective lead boat and maintain close formation while approaching and passing astern of the Commodore's Flagship and other VIP boats.

In the event the Sail Past is abandoned, Code Flag 'N' will be flown from the main flag mast on the VIP lawn and at the flag mast at the Dinghy Clubhouse. The abandonment will also be communicated via electronic means.

The assembly areas on water are shown aside. When in your assembly area please follow directions from your lead boat.

All boats are asked to travel in a clockwise direction in their assembly area to avoid confusion between skippers.

FSC Marshall boat, Gemini RIB will be driven by Harbour Master, Sam Blackburn.

All radio communications will be on VHF Channel 72.

Sections will proceed to the Sail Past area travelling between the 2 buoys and the VIP Boats.


During the Sail Past boats may call "Three Cheers for the Fremantle Sailing Club, Hip-Ray, Hip-Ray, Hip-Ray" when passing the VIP Vessel, "DESTINY", and the Flag Officers and VIPs on Destiny will respond.

Keelboats are to keep engines running during the Sail Past to ensure boats maintain maneuverability throughout.

Power boats are asked to keep wash down and follow the yachts in an orderly fashion.

At the end of the Sail Past please head out to sea before proceeding to your race, or cruise starting area or head back to FSC.

OPENING DAY RACE & CRUISE

- · Keelboats shall refer to Opening Day Sailing Instructions. VHF 72 for Keelboat Racing.
- · Dinghies shall refer to the Dinghy General Sailing Instructions. VHF 74 for Dinghy Racing.
- · Cruising shall refer to the Jib & Main Sailing Instructions. VHF 77 will be used for Jib & Main sailing instead of VHF 72. Course 2 will be used.
