Holiday Fishing Clinic Terms and Conditions

By enrolling my child¹in the FSC Angling Section Holiday Fishing Clinic I make the following declaration, and acknowledge the below terms and conditions:

- The child/children I have registered are medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Clinic. Should any of the said children suffer from or become aware of any illness and/or require medical attention for a pre-existing condition, that condition will be fully disclosed to the Fremantle Sailing Club so that the children are not a danger to themselves or to the health and safety of others. I understand and accept that unless I advise otherwise in writing, the FSC will rely upon this declaration as evidence of the children's fitness and ability to participate in the Clinic.
- If medical assistance is required, FSC will arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation). I authorise such actions being taken by the Club where my further consent cannot be obtained, and agree to meet all costs associated with such action.
- To the maximum extent permitted by law, I understand and agree, as a condition of the registration in the Clinic that the Fremantle Sailing Club disclaims any liability for any injury or damage arising out of the children's participation in the Clinic.

In the event of unfavourable weather the Clinic will be either cancelled or postponed. Parents or a contact listed on the registration form will be notified in the late afternoon two days prior to the Clinic if it is to be cancelled. If the FSC boat Success is available on a day the following week, the event may be rescheduled.

Registration money will be returned to parents whose children can't attend if a new date is set.

The Clinic offers some excellent picture opportunities with many children showing true delight at catching a fish - sometimes their first fish! The Club maintains a gallery of Fishing Clinic photos on its website. Recfishwest, a major supporter of the Clinic, may also want to display photos on its digital platforms.
